REPORT OF OPERATIONS

Fiscal year 1.10.2016 - 30.9.2017

The information presented in the report of operations concerns the Group unless otherwise stated.

Musti Group Holding Group operates in pet retail industry in Finland, Sweden and Norway. In addition, it offers pet groomlng services in both countries and veterinary services in Sweden.

The retail brands in Finland are Musti ja Mirri and Petenkoiratarvike.com. Both brands operate in web retail as well. In Sweden the retail brands are Arken Zoo, Djurmagazinet and Djurmagazinet, of which Arken Zoo also operates in web retail. The retail brand in Norway is Musti. The pet grooming service brands is Trimmis in all operating countries. The veterinary service brand is Vettris.

1. Significant events in the financial year

Network development

At the end of the fiscal year the group had in total 240 stores (2015/14: 230), of which 165 (148) were corporate stores and 75 (82) franchise stores. In Finland the group had 99 (95) corporate stores and 20 (20) franchise stores. In Sweden the group had 57 (52) corporate stores and 55 (62) franchise stores.

During the fiscal year 3 (20) franchise stores were acquired to be corporate stores through asset deals.

During the fiscal year the operations in Norway started. At the end of the fiscal year the group had 9 stores in Norway.

Financial arrangements

During the fiscal year the group companies raised new senior debt financing worth EUR 27.400.000,00 for funding capital expenditure and asset deals.

2. Significant events after the end of the fiscal year

After the ending of the fiscal year, Musti Group has acquired a pet retail change called Djurkompaniet and two web stores called Animail and Vetzoo, all in Sweden. In Norway Musti Group has acquired a pet retail store called Zoobua and two stores through asset deals.

After the ending of the fiscal year, the Musti ja Mirri chain and the Arken Zoo chain have opened three new corporate stores and one new corporate store respectively.

After the ending of the fiscal year, David Rönnberg has been appointed to Group CEO.

3. Assessment of the financial position and the profit for the period

5. Assessment of the probable forthcoming development

All the chains in the group are expected to grow strongly due to opening of new stores and more tempting assortment of goods and services. The profitability is expected to improve both in absolute and relative terms.

6. Risks and uncertainties

The group risk profile follows the general risk level in retail and fast-moving consumer goods industry. The industry is not particularly sensitive to economic fluctuations or to rapid changes. Major part of group purchases is made in US dollars and UK pounds. Over 90% of these purchases were hedged through average forward hedges. The hedging strategy is continuing on same principles also on the next fiscal period. The EUR 29 million interest hedge executed in the previous fiscal year remains in force. Risks relating to ordinary operations are mitigated by accident and liability insurances.

7. Board of Directors, personnel, management and auditors

Mika Sutinen serves as the CEO of the company. In addition to hlm, the group management team consists of Group CFO, Logistics Director, Chain Director for Finland, Chain Director for Sweden, Chain Director for Norway, the Director of Services, the Director of Marketing, the Director of HR, the Commercial Director, the Purchasing Director, the Director of Development and the Director of Operations.

The members of the Board of Directors are Johan Dettel (chairman), Jarkko Murtoaro and Annika Schauman.

The auditor appointed for the company is the Authorised Accounting Firm KPMG Oy Ab. The auditor with the main responsibility is Lasse Holopainen, Authorised Public Accountant.

8. Shares of the company

The share capital of the company is EUR 11,001,853.68, divided into 1,090,459 no par value shares in six different classes of shares. The votes in the different classes of shares and the rights to dividends and assets of the company are based on the shareholder's agreements. The shares are being stressed by the consent clause and the redemption clause.

9. Key conditions of the convertible loan

Based on the authorization in force, the Board of Directors has raised a convertible loan of EUR 4,400,000 to finance acquisitions. The loan has been given by Millan Holding S.â.r.I on the 27th of September 2017. The loan is interest-free and can be fully or partly converted to equity if Millan Holding S.â.r.I so decides. If the loan is not converted, it is repaid in year 2066. After the ending of the fiscal year, the loan has been repaid.

10. Valid authorizations of the Board of Directors for the issue of shares and the emission of options and other special rights that entitle to shares

In the extraordinary shareholders' meeting held on the 13th of May 2016, it was decided to authorize the Board of Directors of the company to decide on directed share issues for a maximum of 300.00 shares.

The Board of Directors was authorized to decide to whom and in which order the shares are issued. The Board of Directors was also authorized to decide all the other terms and conditions regarding the share issues. The authorization is in force until the 1st of June 2017.

11. Suggestion for the distribution of profits

The loss of the period of Musti Group Holding Oy was EUR 42,387.47 and the distributable earnings EUR 99,048,021.65. The Board proposes that no dividend is distributed and the loss of the financial period will be transferred to retained earnings.

ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES FOR THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS SEPTEMBER 30TH, 2017

Financial statements and annual report of Musti Group Holding Oy are prepared in accordance with Finnish laws and regulations. All group companies have been consolidated into group financial statements.

Scope of the consolidated financial statements

All group companies have been consolidated into the consolidated financial statements.

In addition to Musti Group Holding Oy, the financial statements include those subsidiaries where the Group directly controls over 50% of the voting rights.

More detailed information on the companies and associate companies that are part of the Group are given hereafter in the investments section of the notes to the financial statements.

Internal shareholding

The consolidated financial statements have been prepared using the acquisition cost method. The difference between the acquisition cost of the subsidiary companies and the equity that corresponds to the aquired share is presented as consolidated goodwill.

Internal transactions

Internal transactions, receivables and liabilities and the internal distribution of profits have been eliminated.

Minority interests

Minority interests have been separated from the Group's shareholders' equity and earnings and are presented as a separate item.

Foreign currency exchange rate

Foreign currency business transactions are recorded at the rates of exchange of the transaction date. At the end of the fiscal period open foreign currency transactions are valued at the average rates of exchange of the transaction date

The income statements of foreign subsidiaries have been converted into euros at the average rate and balance sheets at the rate on the balance sheet date. The exchange differences arising in the conversion and translation differences arising in the conversion of shareholders' equity of the foreign subsidiaries are presented in the item retained profit in the consolidated balance sheet.

Realized profit/losses of exchange rate agreements are reported as part of costs of goods sold and unrealized profit/losses as part of the notes to the financial statements.

Interest Swaps

Realized profit/losses of interest swaps are reported as financial income/expenses. Unrealized profit/losses are reported as part of notes to the financial statements.

Deferred taxes

The accumulated difference in planned depreciation and the depreciation shown in separate financial statements of the parent company and subsidiary companies is divided in the consolidated balance sheet into shareholders' equity and liabilities and deferred tax liability, and their change in the consolidated income statement in the change to deferred tax liabilities and in the earnings for the period. Deferred tax assets or liabilities are entered on the temporary differences between the accounting and taxation in so far as it is likely that they can be used.

Non current assets

Intangible and tangible assets are marked on the balance sheet at cost less accumulated scheduled depreciations. Depreciations according to plan are recognised on a straight-line bases over the economic lives. Depreciations has started on the 1st day of the month of the commissioning of the fixed assets.

Inventories

Inventories are stated at the direct acquition cost, or at the current selling price, if it is lower than the acquisition cost. The principle of undervaluation is used for the inventoirres in the company and it is based on the estimated storage period calculated for each article.

Financial assets

Financial assets are stated at the acquision cost or at current market value if lower than the acquisition cost.

Adjustments to previous years

The Group's internal stock value of EUR 3.257.288 and the related change in deferred tax assets EUR 564.134,24 has been booked on the previous year's profit / loss account. Corresponding entry has also been made to the comparative balance sheet for the financial period 1.10.2015 - 30.9.2016.
